The CHL Outreach Educator works under direct supervision of the FAS Project Manager for the Children's Healthy Living Program and the Vice President (VP) for Cooperative Research and Extension (CRE) at COM-Palau Community College. Conducts situation analysis, identifies national and local data sources relevant to children health and assembles data, assists Lead Site Co-I identify projects for trainees, coordinates and assists in development and implementation of pilot intervention projects, and performs program monitoring and evaluation. Provides assistance to and takes direction from FAS Project Manager and the VP, Cooperative Research & Extension (CRE).

Identifies and interfaces with food and health initiatives with a focus on child nutrition, physical activity, and obesity prevention. Work closely with community, educational, and government organizations for outreach, recruitment, collaboration, situation analysis, and data collection.

Works with FAS Lead Site Co-Investigator, FAS Project Manager, and CRE VP to develop and implement nutrition-related outreach program in areas such as situation analysis, pilot intervention studies, and program evaluation.

Assist in the development of educational outreach materials for site. Must read, write and speak fluent Palauan, and have a valid Palauan driver's license.

Minimum Qualification Requirements:

- Associates degree in nutrition, public health, food systems, or related field
- 2 years of teaching experience or experience in community development work.
- Excellent written and oral communication skills.
- Proven ability to work effectively with community groups and state and national government agencies.
- Best if reside in Palau.
